

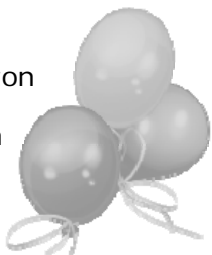

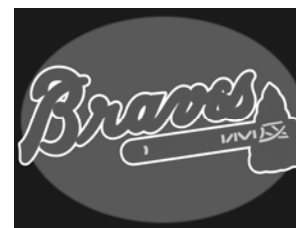

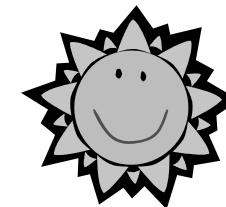
Focus - Fun Raising!
